IV. Announcements and Updates

- ONA Registration with the Oregon Secretary of State - Papers have been filed with the Oregon Secretary of State to establish the Oceanside Neighborhood Association (ONA) as a non-profit.
- Oceanside Village Gathering – With the assistance of a dozen volunteers the Oceanside Village Gather was held July 29, 2017, at the Oceanside Community Club (OCC) Hall. It is estimated that approximately 140 people attended the event. Postcards were placed out for people to provide information about their interest in ONA. The postcard responses increased the ONA email list to 275. The Village gathering gave the ONA and the OCC the opportunity to work together and future build a working relationship.
- Oceanside Community Club Outreach and Hall Agreement – The OCC has graciously agreed to allow the ONA to use the OCC Hall, guaranteeing use and that the ONA meetings will not be bumped once scheduled.
- Bylaws Committee – The committee will meet and provide and update at the ONA November meeting Committee members are Judson Randall (Chair), Jerri Sly, Jerry Keene, Pam Zielinski and Rob Hoeper.
- Proposal to explore access improvement at the beach wayside – Bob Semet agreed to the lead on applying for a grant from the County's Transient Tax for funding to approve beach access.
- Paving update – Work should began on Portland Avenue September 11, 2017 and could take a week or two. No plans to start work on Cape Meares Road. The new Tillamook Public Works Director, Chris Laity, will attend the November 4, 2017 meeting.

V. Neighborhood forum – There was discussion about the ongoing issue of poor cell phone reception in Oceanside. Appreciation was given for the Community Updates provided by Jerry Keene. Paul mentioned the Stinson has backed off on spraying insecticide and hasn't done it for years.
